It all started as the Wymond family farm in the 1800's. Their home was as an essential part of the underground railroad, hiding escaped slaves in a secret room of the farm house. In 1926, a group of businessmen conceived the idea of a country club. They purchased the Wymond Estate overlooking the Wilson Creek Valley and established the home as the centerpiece of the club. In 1992, the club board decided to change the original 9-hole golf course to the current 18-holes. On February 3, 2003, fire destroyed the old mansion. Now standing on the site of the original clubhouse, is a 25,000-square foot state of the art facility.

In 2010, the largest independent banquet operations in the tristate began hosting meetings, banquets, and weddings at the Dearborn Country Club. Receptions Inc. menus and packages are offered for all banquets, and with three different sized banquet rooms, any party size can be handled. The Club also manages outdoor, tented events at Veraestau Historic Landmark and Mission Heights Farm.
