

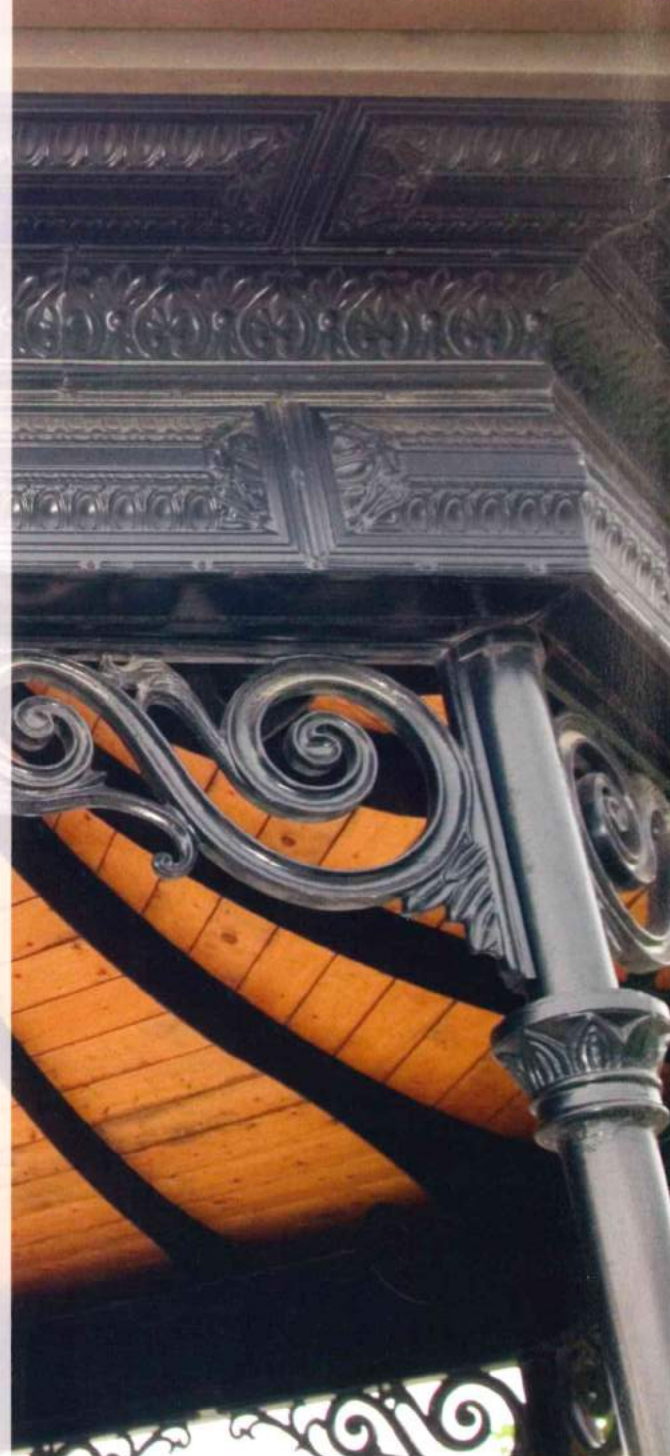

At the turn of the century the five foot bench was on all of the Greenline Steamboats that navigated the Ohio and Mississippi rivers. In the 1930's the New York City Park System was expanded and the 6' version was shipped by the thousands. During the last 119 years, the Stewart Iron Works Company has manufactured this bench in over 30 different variations for suppliers throughout the United States. The New York City Park Bench™ now graces city streets and parks across America.

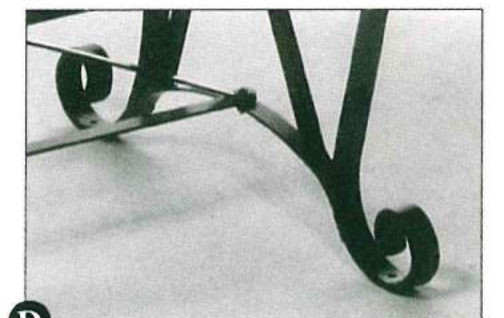
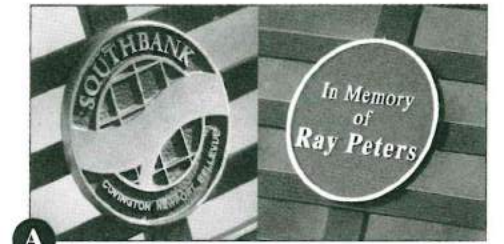
