Under the Street Department Supervisor individuals will be assigned such duties as garbage and trash collection, recycling, wood chipping, painting, mow grass and operate lawn care equipment, hand digging, concrete finishing, general construction, equipment maintenance, cleaning and maintaining city park facilities & equipment, landscape maintenance and event coordination. Must possess ability to work outside in all-weather types

Lifeguards for Aurora City Pool – Part Time

Lifeguards need to be certified and possess the following skills:

- Lifeguards must be strong swimmers who can maneuver and navigate in the water even while carrying another person
- Possess the ability to observe and monitor swimmers and safety conditions is vital and lifeguards should possess excellent observation skills
- Ensure swimmer safety
- Emergency response skills – to calmly assess the situation and make critical decisions to provide assistance if a swimmer is in danger
- Lifeguards need to effectively communicate with visitors and other lifeguards, so strong verbal communication skills are another requirement

Additional requirements:

- Must be a resident citizen of the United States
- Must be 18 years old to apply (16 years old for Lifeguards)
- Must have a high school diploma or GED certificate if currently not attending school
- Must possess a valid driver's license
- Must be able to pass a background check
- Must pass a mandatory pre-employment drug screening test
