

## The Aurora Police Department is currently accepting applications for the position of police officer

Applicants must be between the ages of 21 - 35 and able to pass a background check.

During the hiring process applicants will be required to subject themselves to various forms of background checks including a polygraph examination, credit check, drug screening, physical fitness testing, written aptitude testing, an interview process, psychological evaluation and other testing that may be deemed appropriate.

Deadline for all applications and resumes is noon Friday June 21, 2019. Applications should be returned to the Aurora Clerk-Treasurers Office located at 235 Main Street Aurora, Indiana 47001.

Additional requirements:

- Must be a resident citizen of the United States
- Meet residency requirements consistent with Indiana statute
- Must be 21 years old to apply
- Must have a high school diploma or GED certificate
- Cannot have a felony conviction
- Cannot have a misdemeanor conviction involving domestic violence
- Must possess a valid driver's license
- Cannot have been dishonorably discharged from the military
- Must pass a mandatory drug screening test
- Demonstrate honesty and integrity, by successfully completing pre-employment polygraph testing.
