Mayor Mark Drury issues emergency executive order regarding COVID-19 virus

As a result of the current international pandemic of the COVID-19 virus, and its potential serious health effects to our residents, I am hereby closing all city buildings to the public, effective immediately. During this time:

- City employees will be working and available to answer phone calls and emails.
- All police, fire and emergency services will remain operational. Please check the city website for further information.
- Trash pick-up will continue as usual, unless otherwise notified. We also ask that you please do not leave any additional items outside of your trash receptacles at this time.
- All regular scheduled public meetings are cancelled until further notice.
- Utility bills may be paid by mail, on-line, or placed in the payment box outside of the Utility Office

Please follow President Trump's preventative measures to help control and contain the spread of the COVID-19 virus, which includes limiting gatherings to no more than 10 people, keeping a social distance from others, frequent hand washing and covering sneezes and coughs.
