

Recycling Categories

Although the guidelines surrounding what can and cannot be recycled can be mystifying, the following outline can be used to determine what to recycle and how to prepare those items for the recycler.

It's a shame, but everything cannot be recycled. Some materials must still go to the landfill because there is either no market for the material or the process for recycling efficiently has not been developed. Those things that are recycled must be prepared in a simple, but necessary way in order to make them a usable raw material for the recycler.

Recycling Service

The City of Aurora offers **drop-off recycling service** at the Lions Club parking lot located at the corner of Main & Second Streets. This location is always open and is available to anyone who needs recycling service.

Starting on December 10, 2014, city residents are offered **curbside recycling pick-up** on Wednesdays (excluding holidays) at no charge and with no item limit. To receive this service, please call the Aurora Street Department at 926-5403 one business day before pick-up is scheduled to occur.


Contact Aurora Street Dept. to order Paper and Container recycling containers at 812-926-5403. These recycling bins are provided free to city residents.

Container Specification

- (A) It shall be unlawful for any person to place any garbage can or garbage container in or upon any city street, alley, or other public way for collection of garbage or other wastes therefrom, unless such can or garbage container has a tight fitting and properly workable lid over the mouth or opening of such can or container and weighs less than 50 lbs.
- (B) Any can, box, sack, or other container, weighing more than 50 pounds gross and placed for pick up and disposal of the contents thereof may be refused and passed over.

The Garbage Dilemma

The problem of how to manage solid waste around the country and in Dearborn County is a plaguing issue. The State of Indiana has mandated that, due to shrinking landfill space, all Indiana counties must reduce their total output of trash. Many new operating rules and taxes have been placed on Indiana landfills which reflect back to residents in the form of higher service fees. Recycling has been offered as a solution, which needs to be adopted by everyone in our growing population. We must practice recycling and teach our children that their future depends on it. Help make our community a safe, beautiful and clean environment.

Place these items in your **green** recycling bin. Please keep paper and containers separated.

- brown, white & gray paper boxes
- food boxes & paper bags
- paper towel & toilet paper rolls
- cardboard boxes (flattened)
Flattened boxes must fit in bin or be cut to 3x3 and placed under bin.
- newspaper & inserts, magazines, office paper & envelopes

NO pizza boxes, drink cartons, Styrofoam egg cartons or carry-out containers, soiled paper

containers

Place these items in your **blue** recycling bin. Rinse all containers. Please keep paper and containers separated.

- Aluminum Cans
- Steel / Tin Cans
food cans, any size
- Plastic Bottles #1 & #2
Bottles have necks/openings that are smaller than their bases.

NO PLASTIC bags, wraps, films, tubs, oil containers
NO METAL: aerosol containers, aluminum foil or food pans
NO GLASS

Glass can be brought to the drop-off recycling service located at the Aurora Lion's Club.

Trash & Recycling Service

1. The City of Aurora provides trash pick-up for City residents through Rumpke. A monthly fee is billed through Aurora Utilities per each residence/business.
2. Large business/commercial and residential multi-family units containing 5 or more dwellings shall have the option of securing their own provider of a privately paid service and be exempt from the city fee by showing proof of trash collection billing to the Utility Office.
3. Trash collection will be scheduled Monday thru Thursday with streets assigned for daily pickup. Go to aurora.in.us for a street map. Any brush or loose items must be bundled. All SERVICE related calls must be reported to Rumpke at 1-800-828-8171.
4. The Recycling Service will be on Wednesday and must be at the curbside by 2:00 AM. Skips will not be picked up until the following week
5. Dumpster service is available through Rumpke at 1-800-828-8171 or you can pay fee to dump by the truckload at Aurora Street Dept. at 107 Manchester Landing, Aurora, Indiana 47001 from 8:30 AM to 3:30 PM Monday through Friday.
6. Contact City of Aurora at 812-926-5403 for pick-up of excess and large removal service as follows:
 - a. City residents disposal fee or disposal fees for City workers to pick-up items from city residents are a minimum fee of \$45 per pick up, regardless of size or number of items, but shall not exceed a pick-up truck load, \$75 per pick-up for a load requiring a trailer for removal, and \$100 per pick-up for a load requiring a dump truck for removal.
 - b. All disposal items are subject to city's discretion of whether to accept and dispose of the item(s). If trash removal of items by City workers occurs then the property owner may be subject to excess and large removal service fees on Utility Bill for a resident's failure to properly dispose of garbage or Rumpke's inability to pick up excess and large removal service items.
 - c. Large brush piles – priced on site.
 - d. No tires, shingles, asbestos, or hazardous materials.
7. Dumpster for excess or large item disposal service is located at 107 Manchester Landing (Behind CVS past Aurora Dog Park).

2024 \$14.18 per Household

Privately owned tote units are permitted. All Aurora residents and small businesses can lease a 95-gallon trash cart for \$4 per month. To order call Rumpke at 1-800-828-8171.
